About the software This software can be used to teach English and Bahasa Melayu. It is interactive software and has been developed to assist students learn to read and write who have significant language delay or are non verbal and who have failed to make progress with literacy skills. These tools allow you to quickly create customised reading and writing material using photos and video so that students are motivated to learn from personalised books.

Note Bring: either a laptop or a tablet PC with Windows 7 or later installed, or for touch screen laptops Windows 10 is required. **Make sure the laptop has the latest Windows Updates Installed.** Bring a mobile phone or camera (tablet camera will do) and also include a cable to connect the phone to your computer. The software will run on a Mac computer but only if it has Microsoft Windows installed.
